Time for a Change

What resulted was exemplification of the Second Degree. It would be fair to say that, all in all, this was a very unsatisfactory experience. atmosphere was a bit less than electric as the Office Bearers and floor workers went through their paces. We were grateful to Bro Alex Johnston who stood in as the 'candidate' and gave a good impersonation of someone going through the experience for the first time even though he knew all the answers thoroughly. It would also be fair to say that the Brethren involved in the ceremonial (including yoiurs truly) did not exactly bring their 'A game' along. The team was very experienced and didn't even need the practice!

Prior to the meeting, Bro Hector Macphail PM had floated the idea that we should not be working exemplifications at all for the reasons outlined in the preceding paragraph and that other avenues should be explored.

He brought it, informally, before the RWM and the brethren of the Lodge in discussion before and after the meeting. The conclusion reached was that, in future, we should see the withdrawal of a candidate as an opportunity to do something something different, innovative, something creative. have enough talent in No XII to have talks, lectures, musical items and the like that would enhance the knowledge of the brethren and entertain them in a way that an exemplification does not. As a result, we have seen the last exemplification in No XII and steps will be taken to have a wee programme of events put together to hold in readiness for use as and when required.

Funnily enough, when you look in the Minute books from the early part of the 20th century, No XII degrees were often enhanced by a lecture or talk after the ceremonial had been concluded. Sometimes these were masonic in nature and content and sometimes not.

So, it's back to the future again as we take No XII forward.

Wednesday 22nd March 1916

Presentation of Mark Tools from Lodge Crawfurdsburn No1121

The RW Master expressed the pleasure it gave him to acknowledge another gift from Lodge Crawfurdsburn No 1121. On this occasion it took the form of Mark Tools consisting of 4 Gavels, 3 Chisels, 3 Set Squares and 1 T Square.

The tools are used to this day.
