During his term in Office Bro MacFeate aims to continue the growth of the Lodge, further enhance its involvement in the community, continue its significant charitable work and support Sister Lodges in Scotland

and beyond. Brethren from Lodge Spazio-Tempo Numero 11, Bologna, Italy are expected to attend the Installation with many other visitors from nearer at hand. As is the tradition in No XII, the Deputation of Visiting Brethren will be led by Bro William Lawson, RWM of Lodge Doric Kilwinning No 68.

Bro MacFeate and his Office Bearers will be installed by Bros Iain White, Hector Macphail and Kenneth K. Morrison, all Past Masters of No.XII.

Captain MacFeate, a retired Master Mariner, has lived most of his life in Inverclyde and was educated at Gourock and Greenock High Schools. His nautical career commenced with his pre-sea Cadet Officer training at the James Watt Memorial College, William Street, Greenock, where he later studied for his 2nd Mates and 1st Mates Certificates. He then attended College in Glasgow for his Masters Certificate.

His earlier years were spent on cargo passenger liners as a Cadet Officer rising to the rank of Chief Officer trading to and from the UK and Europe to the Far East. He then transferred to the Offshore Industry, spending sixteen years on the Scott-Lithgow built Drill Ship Ben Ocean Lancer, where he was promoted to Master.

He has a keen interest in local sports and is a member of Greenock Wanderers Rugby Cub, Greenock Cricket Club and Gourock Golf Club and most especially enjoys being a Granddad.

As always, the Installation will be a special evening for No XII. Instituted in 1728, the Lodge was represented at Mary's Chapel, Edinburgh at the institution of The Grand Lodge of Scotland on November 30^{th} 1736. It is, in fact, the oldest organisation in Inverclyde. Since 1765, No XII has had a very close association with Greenock Corporation and now Inverclyde Council. The Lodge made an agreement at that time with the Magistrates and Council to purchase a share in the property of the new Town House then being built. The contribution made was the equivalent, in present day terms, of £2 million. In recognition of this close relationship, Depute Provost Bro David Wilson will attend to represent Inverclyde Council. The Lodge's long links with the Shaw Stewart family will be recognised by the attendance of Sir Ludovic Shaw Stewart 12^{th} Baronet of Greenock and Blackhall at the Installation Dinner.

Yet another splendid evening was enjoyed in the Lodge on 21st October. The Fellowcraft Degree ceremony was carried out by our friends from Lodge Crawfurdsburn Greenock No 1121. Lodge Crawfurdsburn brought a deputation of over 20 brethren led by RWM Bro Hugh Docherty. Thereafter the degree was worked in a very sincere and accomplished manner.

At the Centenary Dinner, Bro Alan Beck' RWM of No XII entertained the brethren in song and Bro Iain White PM proposed the Toast to Lodge Crawfurdsburn. Bro Iain is an Honorary Member of Lodge Crawfurdsburn.

At the end of the meeting a large number of brethren waited behind for some Lodge hospitality.

It was proposed to give the sum of 12 Guineas to local charities, to be allocated as follows:-

Donation of £50 to Building Fund of Freemasons' Hall, Edinburgh

With reference to the application of Grand Lodge for a donation to the Building Fund of the New Freemasons' Hall, it was agreed to contribute the sum of £50.

In present day sums, the £12-12/- would be around £1222.00 and the £50 around £4453.00. in this sense our present day and 1910 commitments are similar in No XII.
