A match of 12 ends was decided upon with the ancient bowling tradition of a break at the half way mark for refreshment being observed before the return to labour for the second half of the match. The competition was keen with much animated chat and banter filling the air above Ardgowan Square. When the result was totted up, it was a victory for Lodge Crawfurdsburn by 46 shots to 30.

With a little regret, RWM Bro Bob Bain of No XII presented the trophy to Past Master Bro Jimmy Miller. It was generally agreed (by the No XII team at least) that the result was of secondary importance. What is indisputable is that the friendship between the two Lodges was enhanced by this social gathering and the bond between them further strengthened by the cement of brotherly love that was spread.
